- The crime that was reported and the information provided
- The exact location where the crime
- occurred
- The date and time the crime occurred
 The date and time it was reported to you
- Any witness and perpetrator information
- Victim information, unless the victim requests confidentiality

CSAs are not responsible for determining whether a crime took place, only to report the information promptly
