## What to report:

- The crime that was reported and the information provided
- The exact location where the crime occurred
- The date and time the crime occurred
- The date and time it was reported to you
- Any witness and perpetrator information
- Victim information, unless the victim requests confidentiality

*\*\*CSAs are not responsible for determining whether a crime took place, only to report the information promptly\*\**

## Arrests and Referrals for Disciplinary Action

## Violence Against Women Act (VAWA) Offenses

- Domestic Violence
- Dating Violence
- Stalking

## Criminal Offenses

- Criminal homicide: murder and non-negligent manslaughter, manslaughter by negligence
- Sexual offenses: rape, fondling, incest, statutory rape
- Robbery
- Aggravated assault
- Burglary
- Motor vehicle theft
- Arson

## Hate Crimes

- Any of the offenses listed under "Criminal Offenses"
- Larceny-theft
- Simple Assault
- Intimidation
- Destruction/damage/vandalism of property

*\*\*CSAs aren't expected to know what counts for the crimes listed here. It is best to report an incident either way; we have staff to review all incoming reports who are trained on what constitutes a crime.\*\**
