Opening Discussions: Grace L. McCann Morley: the career of the San Francisco Museum of Modern Art's first director presentation and discussion with Dr. Berit Potter, Assistant Professor in the Art Department was enlightening and interesting. We had good attendance at this presentation.

Spring Presenters: We will continue to meet over zoom for the next luncheon presentations. We will hopefully have in-person presentations at the Plaza Grill View Room in the Fall. James will investigate the technical facilities there to see if some participants listen to the presentations via Zoom. We agreed that presentations should be 45 to 50 minutes leaving time for questions and discussions. Upcoming:

- 12 May 2022: *Seaweed the New Weed in Humboldt* a presentation and discussion with Dr. Rafael Cuevas Uribe, Associate Professor in the Department of Fisheries Biology. James will do the introduction.

Membership: In February, we added 7 new members, and 4 previous members re-upped. Our membership now stands at 45 paid memberships. 7 of the newly 16 inducted emeriti are now members of ERFSA. We agreed that online payment of membership dues is preferable.

Treasurer's Report: Due to market conditions, our HAF account has lost \$2,363. We started January with \$53,826, stand now at \$51,460, and anticipate further losses in March. This may influence how much we distribute in small grants. Our Cal Poly Humboldt account stands at \$3,459 which is up due to new memberships.

According to Humboldt County Public Health for our age groups, the number of people partially and fully vaccinated is between 94.52%---100%


