## PROMOTING CLEAN WATER AND HEALTHY HABITATS WHERE WE LIVE AND PLAY!

North Coast Otters—public arts initiative was conceived when considering the rivers, wetlands, lagoons, and coastlines where wild river otters live with fish and other creatures in our region’s rich habitats, which were originally tended by local indigenous communities. All natural beings have their own story and/or song, as is expressed by the names for river otter in some of the region’s original languages, including:

**HUPA:** lo:q’-yiditile, *salmon-it relishes, craves*

**KARUK:** pay sárúk, *down by river one*

**TOLOWA DEE-NI’:** naa-ghaa-t’uu-ne, *they are swimmers together*

**WIYOT:** sukseswilh, *takes an ugly mouthful*

**YUROK:** ne-pe’-weesh-neg, *fish eater*
