

Cal Poly Humboldt Emergency Purchase Authorization Form

Ref. PCC § 1102, 10340 (b) (1), CSU Contracts and Procurement Policy Limits on Competition, Section II.E Exceptions to Competition Requirements.

"Emergency" as used in the Public Contract Code, means a sudden, unexpected occurrence that poses a clear and imminent danger, requiring immediate action to prevent or mitigate the loss or impairment of life, health, property, or essential public services.

When an emergency involving the public health, welfare, or safety, or the protection of State property or programs requires the immediate issuance of a purchase order, standard agreement, or service order without a formal issuance of bid invitations, this Emergency Authorization Form shall be attached to the requisition and be signed by both the requestor and the campus procurement officer. Such statement shall include an attestation that an immediate threat to the public health, welfare, or safety or damage to State property exists.
