The Trustees of the California State University will receive sealed bid proposals via email only to addie.dunaway@humboldt.edu & procure@humboldt.edu, for furnishing all labor and services for the above-named Project, Project Number PW25-A-1, for the Cal Poly Humboldt campus. Proposals will be received to the above-mentioned emails until 3:00 p.m. on May 2, 2025, in accordance with the contract documents, at which time the proposals will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the work consists of the testing and inspection of the campus fire alarm system within the buildings included on the Fire Alarm & Sprinkler System Inventory by Building (Exhibit E) in accordance with the plans and specifications prepared by the Project Manager; construction estimate is not disclosed.

Each bidder offering a proposal must have a current registration with Department of Industrial Relations (DIR) and possess a current California Contractor's Licenses C-10 **and** C16.

Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises Contractual Participation Goals, Regulations and Procedures: Due to the nature of the services which are the subject of this bid, this project has been exempted from compliance with DVBE requirements.

Each bidder shall be familiar with all the provisions of the General Provisions, especially the Insurance Requirements (Exhibit B)

This project is a public works project and is subject to prevailing wage rate laws (Contract General Conditions, Article 4.02). All contractors and all tiers of subcontractors who will work on this project shall register to bid and work on public works projects with the Dept. of Industrial Relations, and maintain current this registration pursuant to Labor Code section 1725.5.
