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1. Clearly list all assumptions used when creating this proposal.

The very successful degree completion program costs have consistently increased, even with solid enrollment numbers, we saw a negative net revenue for the last two years. The proposed \$360/unit for Leadership Studies will enable maintaining a manageable net revenue negative for approximately two years, and with subsequent fee raising to approximately \$425-485, we should be able to project a net revenue slightly positive.

2. Clearly state the expenditures that will be funded by this proposed revenue source.

The majority of expenditures will go directly to faculty teaching and benefit costs that continue to increase, as well as, staff and student assistants that are integral to running the operations. Other expenditures will show minor increases, and assume CPI approximately 2%.

3. Clearly state the reason(s) why this fee or fee increase is necessary (include references to executive orders, CA law, etc.)

The FY22-23 Actuals and Q3-4 Projections show Leadership Studies will run a deficit of over \$38,900, and this is the second year of running a deficit. The majority of the cost of the program is in wages and benefits, so annual increases, and inflation, has made it necessary to raise the fees. In addition, comparatively speaking, we are one of the most affordable programs; the CSU Professional and Continuing Education degree programs typically charge \$400 or more per unit. This is the first fee increase to the program, since it began in 2014.

4. Clearly articulate why the level of fee proposed is the appropriate amount to charge.

he fee proposed is not a substantial increase, and this request is an incremental adjustment to see the overall change in revenue and enrollments. The next increase will produce a net revenue positive, however, we are seeing this implementation as the best way to test the market, taking appropriate and sustainable measures, while also studying any impact on enrollments. Currently, the Leadership Studies degree completion program is the least expensive in the CSU system.

At \$360/unit, the \$1,080 for a 3 unit course aligns with financial aid students receive. For instance, many utilize employer reimbursement which averages at \$5K/year. If a student is taking 5 LDRS courses per year, that would be a total tuition cost of \$5,400. Another factor is in partnership with Financial Aid, the highest need students are eligible for Middle Class Scholarship, Cal Grant, and Pell Grant (37% receive
