Title: Complimentary Permit Guideline

This standard shall be utilized by Parking & Commuter Services staff to determine whether or not an individual or entity is qualified to receive a complimentary parking permit:

The following shall be eligible for complimentary parking permits:

• Distinguished Guest

o Individuals invited to campus by University leadership to advance the goals of HSU.

• Members of the University Advancement Foundation Board

- o Qualified for an annual permit applicable to general, resident, and faculty/staff parking areas and valid for those activities directly associated with the Board.
- o Only applicable to those members not employed by the University.

• Community Directors of the Sponsored Programs Foundation Board as Appointed by the President

o Qualified for an annual permit applicable to general, resident, and faculty/staff parking areas and valid for those activities directly associated with the Board.

• Emeritus Faculty

o As defined and outlined in Operating Standard 001.

Students with Disabilities

o As defined and outlined in Operating Standard 002.

• Faculty & Staff During Summer Term

o As defined and outlined in Operating Standard 008.

• Prospective Students & Their Families Visiting the Campus in Association with a Scheduled Campus Tour.

o Permits will be issued by Parking & Commuter Services upon proof of scheduled campus tour and are only available at the Parking Kiosk located in Lot G11.

Staff & Faculty on First Day of Work.

Permits will be issued to employees on their first week of employment.
Requests must come via email to Parking & Commuter Services at least 24 hours in advance.

30 Minute Load/Unload Permits

- Semester permits can be requested by emailing <u>parking@humboldt.edu</u>. Daily permits are available at the Parking Kiosk.
- Deliveries: If the company is making deliveries and has a commercial license plate, the delivery driver may park in loading and unloading zones for up to 20 minutes, or as marked.
